Not sure if this information would help you in your investigation ...

On a Sunday, the same date as a UCP Bowling night, in October, 2003, Tina Hayden and Shirley Ulberg were with me in my van on the way back to Chippewa Falls. Tina told us that she had an appointment with her Ob/Gyn on the next day, Monday morning. Tina wanted either Shirley or Don to go with her, because she was scared. Shirley told Tina that she had to work Monday, but would Tina allow Don to go with her? Tina said that she wanted Don to go with her if Shirley couldn't. So, Monday morning, I went to pick up Tina for her doctor's appointment. When I got to Lakeside, and up to see Tina, Tina was just finishing her Breakfast. Then Cindy Puetz came over and asked why I was there. Tina told Cindy that she wanted me to take her to the doctor's appointment. Cindy "blew up" and got very loud, and hostile in front of everyone around the breakfast area, and started getting mad at both Tina and myself. Cindy Puetz started attacking Tina and myself verbally, and belittling Tina in front of everyone. Tina said that she still wanted Don to take her. Cindy got mad, went over to the desk, and canceled Tina's appointment. (This was still while Tina Hayden had her own self-guardianship.) Tina started to cry, but Cindy Puetz still belittled her. Then Cindy told me to leave. A big, burly, male nurse came over and glared at me. As I was getting on the elevator, I could

still hear Cindy Puetz hollering at Tina.

I complained to UCP, but nothing happened.

To me, Cindy Puetz (and Lakeside) were abusing Tina's right to a choice that she was still free to make.

By the way, you should talk to Shirley Ulberg about Tina Hayden. She would have a different view than I would about Tina Hayden.
